Manhattan

Rye whiskey, Carpano vermouth, and Angostura bitters.

Paper Plane

Bourbon, Aperol, Amaro Nonino bitter liqueur, and lemon juice. A complexly flavoured classic with herbal and orange notes.

Penicillin

Johnnie Walker whisky, lemon juice, and honey, all topped with a splash of famously smoky Laphroig 10 whisky.

Scotch Colada

Dewar's Illegals whisky, pineapple juice, lime juice, and coconut crème. A classic with a Scottish twist!

Whisky Sour

Johnnie Walker Red, lemon juice, sugar syrup, and bitters.

The Classic Old Fashioned

Johnnie Walker whisky, brown sugar syrup, Angostura original and orange bitters, finished with an orange peel twist.

The Old Town Fashioned £11.00

A classic old fashioned made with Benriach 10, a fine Speyside single malt whisky, triple-aged for at least a decade in bourbon, sherry, and oak casks.

William's Old Town Fashioned £14.00

A classic old fashioned made with Bowmore 15, a beautifully matured Islay single malt whisky, aged for at least 15 years in bourbon and sherry casks for a chocolatey and fruity aroma with subtle layers of smoke.

Bloody Mary Kings Close

Arbikie chilli vodka, tomato juice, lemon juice, Tabasco and Worcestershire sauce, made to your specified degree of spiciness.

Caramel White Russian

Greedy Fox Caramel & Honeycomb rum and Kahlua, topped with equal parts milk and cream and dusted with chocolate powder.

Classic White Russian

Stolichnaya vanilla vodka, Kahlua, topped with equal parts milk and cream and dusted with chocolate powder.

Classic Daiquiri

Bacardi Blanco, lime juice, and sugar syrup – can be made classic, strawberry, raspberry or peach.

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Eiffel's Rose

Courvoisier V.S. Cognac, Cointreau premium triple sec, lemon, apple juice and Grenadine.

Espresso Martini

Stolichnaya vanilla vodka, Kahlua, and double shot of espresso.

Margarita

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WHISKY FLIGHTS

Breakfast Whisky Flight

“A great way to start your journey into the world of whisky” £20.00

Auchentoshan 12 – Lowland whisky offers an oaky and sweet palate, with barley sugar and vanilla.

Arran 10 – Island whisky, sweet and quite malty, reminiscent of digestive biscuits with subtle smoke.

Deveron – Highland whisky with a core of butterscotch and waxy malt, apple pie and the sea.

Regional Picks

“Wee dabble into different whisky regions of Scotland” £20.00

Benriach The Original 10 – Speyside whisky packs plenty of creamy orchard notes and earthy peat.

Glen Scotia Double Cask – Campbeltown whisky is powerful and oily with a touch of German brandy.

Caol Ila 12 – Islay whisky with good body and an oily tar yet elegant smokiness. Hints of boiled sweets.

All about the Smoke

“For the lover of the peated and smoky malts” £23.00

Ardbeg An Oa – Islay malt. Plenty of peaty oomph, although perhaps lighter in body. Notes of golden syrup and black tea.

Isle Raasay - Highlands. Subtly peppery, before notes of fresh cream, digestive biscuit, and buttery toast (very slightly burnt) arrive.

Kilchoman Sanaig – Islay. Light fruits (this time of the peach variety), with dark chocolate raisins and a whisper of red berries. Peat grows and grows, with a little black pepper too.

Art of the Finish

“A house favourite and a great example in the art of whisky making” £23.00

Glenmorangie Quinta Ruben 14 – Highland whisky with a fantastic port cask finish, expressions of chocolate mousse, Bourbon biscuits, orange oil, toasted almond notes, blackcurrant and raisin.

Bowmore 15 – Islay whisky finished in sherry casks, imparting a rich sweetness that blends well with smoky and peaty elements and rich, woody pine oil. Syrupy, creamy toffee and malt finish.

Balvenie 14 Caribbean Cask – Speyside whisky finished in Caribbean rum casks. Sweet vanilla forms a creamy palate with notes of apples, mangoes and a hint of orange.

A Still Pond

“Japanese whisky is still, subtle, perfect and a like a still pond ” £26.00

The Yamazaki – Distillers Reserve – The dried berries remain lively on the palate but they're dialled back a bit to make room for the light oak, white peach and a small amount of spice.

Hibiki Japanese Harmony - Melted butter and caramelised dates. A hint of fragrant sandalwood develops into warming, oak-y spice.

Nikka Days – Smooth and creamy, roasted nuts, toffee apple, toasty malted cereal and vanilla fudge alongside a hint of barrel char, freshened up by juicy apples.

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Pretanic Isles

"A journey into the Anglo-Celtic flavours available in whisk(e)y today" £23.00

Penderyn Maderia Finish – Welsh. Sweet, medium body. Herbal, vanilla, sweetness, resin, sultanas, toast. Over-ripe grape.

Sexton – Irish. Dried fruit followed by honeycomb sweetness, apricots, lemon zest, prunes and oak spice.

The English – Original – English. Nuttier than the nose, with notes of almond and hazelnut. Milk chocolate, more orange.

Dessert Flight

"Drams that daydream about the sweeter side of things" £20.00

Auchentoshan Sauvignon Blanc – Lowland whisky with the smooth triple distilled taste and the unique flavour of Sauvignon Blanc casks that gives a fresh, vibrant take on Auchentoshan.

Glenmorangie Nectar d'Or – Highland whisky finished in syrupy Sauternes wine casks. Silky with syrup sponge and vanilla custard, buttery baklava, and toasted brown sugar notes.

Loch Fyne Chocolate & Orange Whisky Liqueur – Lowland whisky with natural flavourings of chocolate, tangerine, and orange. Less sweet than other liqueurs with a warming aroma of deluxe Scotch.

William's Flight of Fancy

"The finest top shelf malts McGonagall's has to offer" £70.00

Glenfiddich Grand Cru 23 – This Speyside single malt initially ages in American and European oak casks before being moved over to rare French cuvée wine oak casks. A palate of melted butter on rye, sandalwood and peach. Soft peppery hints drift in later with just a pinch of mint.

Arran 21 – An exquisite Island whisky showing off the glorious and characteristic Arran fruit notes, deliciously paired with well-matured oak richness. Orange, chocolate, damson jam, mango, hay, and subtle charred cedar notes develop into a precisely balanced palate.

Dalmore Cigar Malt – This Highland malt was discontinued in mid-2009, causing quite an uproar indeed. The whiskies used for the reworked version were actually slightly older but still naturally pair perfectly with a cigar. Toffee and caramel edge toward the burnt cinder-toffee side of things. Flamed orange-zest and perfectly integrated sherry finish off this masterpiece.

GIN FLIGHTS

A selection of specially curated gin tastings. Each comes with three gins and your choice of two tonics of the following: Fever-Tree Indian, Light, Aromatic, Lemon, Elderflower, Mediterranean and Cucumber Cushiedoos Scottish Tonic.

The Sweet Tooth

"A pick & mix of delightful dessert-like gins for your palate" £19.00

Glas-we-gin Raspberry & Rhubarb – Warm raspberry jam and candied rhubarb dance up from the glass with creamy vanilla notes reminiscent of raspberry ripple ice cream. Fresh, crisp orange flower and lemon peel cut through for a refreshing, long finish with a pink peppercorn tingle.

Boë Violet – A Scottish gin infused with violets alongside other classic gin botanicals. The addition of the flowers creates a stylish gin with a light, delicate taste and beautiful colour and aroma.

Puerto de Indias Strawberry – Distilled using fresh strawberries. Peppery juniper with a good kick of spice, mellowed by the rounded notes of strawberry.

The International

“A fine selection of international gins with herby and spicy botanicals” £19.00

Roku – Complex, multi-layered, yet harmonious flavour of various botanicals. Traditional gin taste in the base, plus characteristic Japanese botanical notes with yuzu as the top note. Smooth and silky texture.

Aviation – Wonderfully spicy notes are more prominent with cardamom shining through a scattering of cinnamon and floral notes.

Monkey 47 – Herbaceous juniper, blackthorn, lavender and an acute resinous pine note that comes across as more spruce and rosemary. As the taste progresses, we get peppery, vegetal notes, harmoniously entwined as if a single botanical.

Highlands and Islands

“Join us on a Caledonian adventure with warm and woody gins” £19.00

The Botanist – Cool mint and juniper, slightly pine-forward. Citrus, primarily lemon zest on the early mid-palate before sweet spices and flowers arise. Woodruff, chamomile and herbs de Provence. Late echoes of vanilla cream, liquorice, and birch bark.

Caorunn – Slightly spicy, full-bodied, and invigorating flavour, with a clean and crisp finish. Modern London Dry gin infused with classic Celtic soul in the form of five locally foraged botanicals.

Kinrara – Warming pine and juicy blueberry, followed by a touch of orange pith. The selection of botanicals includes rowan berries and rosehips, giving it a particularly fruity flavour profile.

The Citrus

“Taste the sun with this selection of citrus gins” £19.00

Lind & Lime – Bright citrus, fresh and authentic. Juniper is subtly spicy, bolstered by pepper and cardamom warmth.

Tanqueray Flor de Sevilla – Moderate to full body with vibrant bitter orange peel early—think marmalade, but a touch less sweet. Becomes drier as it sits on palate. Pine-note juniper and earthy liquorice root lend some classic gin colour towards the end.

Strathearn Citrus – A new style gin with added elements of zest, herbs and spices combining a hint of Italian lemons and Spanish grapefruit with a suggestion of kaffir lime leaves and star anise.

The Edinburgh Gin

“A sweet and fruity selection from this much-loved local distillery” £19.00

Edinburgh Raspberry – Syrupy and intensely flavoured, bursting with fruit on the palate. The finish is a fully rounded, unabashedly taste bursting with natural flavour. Definitive raspberry aromas balance sweet ripeness with a tart edge.

Edinburgh Rhubarb & Ginger – A bright and sociable gin with a little heat, an abundance of fruit, crisp, pine notes and a full finish. Bright aromas of rhubarb and juniper with a gentle sweetness, balanced by a sharp tang, and pop of citrus and spice. A smooth, rounded finish with lingering spice.

Edinburgh Lemon & Jasmine – Sweet heady notes of jasmine blossom, smooth with bold lemon notes balanced by classic juniper.

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The Classics

"Bartenders' favourites that blazed a trail for the current gin craze" £19.00

Tanqueray 10 – A mix of incredibly clean, spicy juniper with hints of Earl Grey tea and cardamom. Very citrus-rich with a long, zesty finish.

Hendricks – Astoundingly fresh notes of cucumber with juniper, oak, a touch more citrus and vanilla. Creamy and savoury followed by a long, refreshing, floral finish.

Brockmans – Nutty, fruity palate with blueberries, juniper, and soft aniseed notes with a short burst of liquorice root and herbs.

Rivers and Oceans

"Traverse the Scottish coasts through gins with sea botanicals" £19.00

Shetland Reel Ocean Sent – Traditional juniper notes with subtle hints of salt and spice. Classic London dry palate with a complex twist of saltiness and warmth. The finish is long and brings you right into crashing waves.

Rock Rose – Fruity & subtly sweet, with juniper, floral, citrus and berry notes. Finishes with sherbet lemon, rose, liquorice and cinnamon.

Edinburgh Seaside – Fresh, lightly floral aroma. A balanced gin with sweet minerality, grassy notes and a hint of spice followed by a pleasingly crisp, slightly sweet finish.
